

1. Organization:



2. Areas:



3. Responsibilities:

- a. The Chairman of the membership and Block Captains' committee will:
- (1) Develop and coordinate the annual membership drive in September of each year.
- (2) Maintain a card file with data on each household to reflect required information for the <u>pirectory</u> and other Association activities.
- (3) Provide data to the Vice President for Publications by the third week in October for publication in the <u>Directory</u>.
- (4) Develop and coordinate an organization of Area Coordinators and block Captains in sufficient depth to ensure:
 - -- prompt delivery of Association newsletters, the <u>Directory</u>, and any special notices.
 - -- an effective annual September membership drive and collection of dues and data for the <u>virectory</u>.
 - -- greeting of new neighbors, inviting them to join the Association, and notifying the Chairman of the welcome wagon Committee of the new arrivals.
 - -- keeping the Secretary-Treasurer apprised of serious illnesses or deaths among family members.
 - -- informing the Vice President for Publications of new arrivals, departures, deaths, births, etc., for inclusion in the Association newsletter.
- b. The Area Coordinators will be selected by the Chairman of the membership and Block Captains' Committee. They will:
- (1) Assist the Chairman in accomplishing his duties witnin the geographic areas as shown in paragraph 2, above.
- (2) Ensure that every home within the assigned area is assigned to a Block Captain.
- (3) Find, train, and maintain a list of block Captains, each of whom are assigned responsibility for approximately 13 nomes.
- (4) Act as the communication funnel for information flowing between the Chairman and the Block Captains.
- c. The Block Captains are assigned responsibility for approximately 13 homes within their immediate neighborhood. They will:
- (1) Conduct an annual membership drive in september of each year.

- (2) Complete a card on each household with data containing information required for the <u>Directory</u> and other Association activities.
 - (3) Collect the annual dues.
- (4) Provide the data cards and dues to the Area Co-ordinator by the first week in october.
- (5) Promptly deliver Association newsletters, the <u>Directory</u>, and any special notices to each assigned nome.
- (6) Greet any new neighbors, invite them to join the Association, and notify the Area Coordinator and the Unairman of the welcome wagon Committee of the new arrivals. Assist the welcome wagon Committee as requested.
- (7) Keep the Area Coordinator and the Secretary-Treasurer apprised of serious illnesses, deaths, or other emergency situations that may require community attention and assistance.
- (8) Inform the Area Coordinator and the Vice rresident for Publications of new arrivals, departures, deaths, births, and other news items for inclusion in the Association newsletters.
