"No appeal to the assessment made by the Real Estate Assessor shall be heard by the Board of Real Estate Equalization of Real Estate Assessments unless application to the Board for relief is made in writing to the Board within thirty days of the date set by the Assessor to hear objections to the assessments or May 1 of the year in which such assessment is made, whichever is later."

The real estate tax rate is set by City Council in April. Until the 2011 rate has been set, the amount of taxes levied for the year cannot be determined. The City Manager will present the proposed budget on February 22, 2011. The City Council will hold public outreach meetings for citizen input on March 15 and 29, work sessions on March 15, 16, 29, April 5 and 12, and public hearings on March 22 and April 12, 2011. City Council will hold a final public hearing, adopt the budget, and set the tax rate on April 28, 2011.
