Speed test results (25 mph) – 1245 vehicles coming and going for three days, the average speed was 18.28. 3 vehicles clocked over speed limit: 41 (1), 37 (1), 35 (1) mph.

The city may be thinking of widening a path from The Commons down to the creek, across a bridge, and up the other side to Rt. 50. It would be wheelchair accessible and there might be a cutout for a small playground off the path.
