BEAUTY SPOT

Early in October, we went out to select this month's Beauty Spot. Oft times, we have the opportunity to chat with the homeowners and tell them we're giving them the award. This month however, when we made our selection, no one was home so we put the sign in the yard and went on our way. Imagine my surprise when I received an email from the homeowners, asking if the sign in their yard was a prank. Congratulations to the Barrineaus of 10002 Boxford Court. It is not a prank! You are the rightful recipients of this October's Beauty Spot of the Month.

While I was a bit puzzled and amused by the query, it made me think about sharing something about why we choose the yards we do. When my husband and I moved to CCH, we bought a home with "wellestablished" gardens. (That's a polite way of saying they were overgrown and needed quite a bit of work.) Knowing almost nothing about gardening, I joined the Country Hills Garden Club, thinking I might learn a few things that would help me maintain our yard. When asked to write Beauty Spot, I readily agreed as long as Joyce Skoglund accompanied me to choose the spots and teach me about plants. I was interested in finding yards that exemplified concepts that perhaps we could all apply to our own gardens.

Over the years, we've learned about hardscapes (think retaining walls, sheds, stone paths), using perennials as foundational plantings (creating canopy and understory structure), living privacy screens, and

adding specimen plants and annuals for visual interest.


October's selection incorporates many of these ideas. It is a great example of well-established (in this case, think well-maintained) beds. On the left of the driveway, at the property border, is a large hedge of laurel, creating a thick, lush privacy screen. There is also a bed with hostas, a hydrangea bush, and a beautiful specimen plant, a miniature Japanese red maple.

The bed to the right of the driveway is planted with azaleas, Rose of Sharon, and a Camelllia (in bud) and hostas. The bed continues around the front of the house with yellow feathery-leafed cypress evergreen, nandina, a huge mound of forsythia, and a large lilac bush anchoring the right corner of the bed.

At the foot of the driveway, is a crepe myrtle surrounded by hostas. And for added visual interest and a pop of autumn color, be sure to take a look at the hanging baskets at the top of the driveway filled with sweet potato vines and petunias.

I'm sure you'll agree, as you can see from the photo (credit goes to Ernie Klimonda), the result is a beautiful, inviting yard, totally worthy of the Beauty Spot of the Month Award!






