CCH ENTRANCE SIGNS REPLACEMENT UPDATE

As we all know, every house needs regular maintenance to keep it looking its best. A fresh coat of paint and regular landscaping: These are the sorts of things that give our homes their curb appeal.

Country Club Hills is our community, our greater home, and its curb appeal could use a bit of sprucing up. If you have walked, biked, or driven past the entrance signs into our community, you can see that although the uprights are still functional, the signs themselves have decayed and are falling apart. These signs are the way we announce to the rest of Fairfax, "We're here!" They need more than a coat of paint. **They need to be replaced.**

This is not an expense your CCHCA Board can take to the city. The initial estimate is \$400 per sign, or

\$1,200 total. We must work together, <u>as a community</u>, to raise the necessary funds.

We are pleased to announce that we are well on our way in raising these funds. In honor of its long-standing involvement in the history of our entry signs, the CCH Garden Club has generously donated \$100. Donations from community members added another \$91, and donations from the CCHCA Board members have brought the grand total so far to \$418—enough for one sign!

However, that still leaves almost \$800 to raise. We need to raise these additional funds as soon as possible, so that we can get the signs replaced before they fall apart entirely. This is where *you* come in: Your CCHCA board will gratefully accept donations both large and small. Please send whatever you can to Amy Levy (checks payable to CCH; put "Entry Signs" on the memo line), 3305 Spring Lake Ct.

Donors who contribute more than \$50 will receive special recognition on the CCHCA website and a small "thank you" token. Ideally, we would like to have all of the funds in hand before the General Membership Meeting in May, so please make your donations today!

As an extra inducement, we are having a contest for design ideas for the signs. There are three categories: Elementary/Middle School students, High School students, and adults. The cost of each entry is \$1 (which will go toward the sign fund), OR an item of nonperishable food (such as canned goods) for donation to a local soup kitchen.

A template for the signs, along with design requirements, is included in this issue of the newsletter. Using this template as the basis for your designs, send or drop off your entries to Jennifer Judelsohn, at 10116 Farmington Drive, by Monday, April 30, 2012. We will put the designs on display at the General Meeting in May where community members will have a chance to view them and make their favorites known!

Thank you for supporting this effort to make the gateways to our community more attractive!



GARDEN TIPS

That ivy that you love so much you let it climb up your trees....did you know that if left untouched it will eventually choke your tree to death? So if you want that tree to survive another 50 years, cut the ivy from around the tree and watch for any new runners and cut them off as well. When planting a number of bulbs in the same area, do not dig individual holes. Instead, try removing soil from the entire area. Prepare the bottom with soil, peat and bone meal, place bulbs and cover them gently.
