





### **CASSEROLES FOR A CAUSE**

Even in a relatively affluent neighborhood like CCH, there are residents—neighbors of ours—who find themselves in difficult circumstances. Life events such as job loss, illness, injury, or death of a loved one create a great deal of stress on the individuals and families experiencing them. Often, in such situations, even taking care of basic needs like preparing meals becomes challenging. Fortunately, nobody has to face these difficulties alone.

In December, we learned of a few families in our neighborhood who were facing challenges. My wife, Jennifer Judelsohn, came up with an idea: Inviting CCH residents to donate casseroles (or ingredients that could be turned into casseroles) to neighbors in need. I put out a call to the CCHCA e-mail list for donations, and the response was overwhelming!

CCH residents pitched in with prepared casseroles, casserole ingredients, and even cash donations (which we used to buy additional ingredients).

We received the following prepared casseroles:

- A chicken and green bean casserole
- A turkey and bean casserole with cornbread
- Two chicken and broccoli noodle casseroles

Jennifer was the Master Chef de Casserole all day. She used the ingredients people dropped off to make:

- Tuna noodle casseroles
- Penne with vegetables and meat sauce
- Ham and asparagus noodle casseroles
- Southwestern-style chicken casseroles with beans and rice
- Shepherd's pies

All told, in a single day we ended up with two dozen meals to deliver to four local families in need. And we still had plenty of ingredients for preparing more meals another day!




