STREET LIGHTS

We will vote for or against street lights at our meeting on June 13.

Two plans are available, and will be discussed.

PLAN I

The Civic Association can pay in advance \$18.50 per year per light installed. The Association can select the location of each light.

PLAN II

To establish a "Small Tax District" comprised of Country Club Hills alone, for the sole purpose of lighting. The establishment of such a tax district will not involve assessments for anything except street lights. The proceedure for this is as follows:

- (1) Petition the Circuit Court with a request for street lighting and establish the proper boundaries.
- (2). Assume an assessment of from 3 cents to 6 cents per \$100. assessed valuation of our homes, per year.
- COMMENTS: Plan 2 allows the County to place lights wherever they deem necessary. (Possibly every third telephone post and at intersections.)

An immediate decision would mean that we would have lights before July 1, 1958, under Plan II.

Plan I can bring us lighting immediately.

These two plans can be combined. #One to get us started, # two to assume responsibility once installed.
