NOTES FROM THE ANNUAL MEETING: BYLAW CHANGES AND NEW BOARD MEMBERS

Annual meeting was held at the Green Acres Center. After several interesting speakers, and reports from the previous year's activities, the Association members who were present unanimously voted amend the bylaws as follows:

Article IX Section 6. Welcoming Committee. This committee shall welcome and provide appropriate information to new arrivals in Country Club Hills and notify the Vice President for Membership and the Vice President for Publications of new arrivals. The gift included in the Welcome Packet shall not exceed 50% of the current membership dues.

Article XII Section 2. A 1 1 disbursements of funds of the check signed by the Treasurer, except the Treasurer may maintain a petty cash fund not to exceed \$50.00. The Treasurer shall disburse Corporation funds excess of \$300.00 only with the consent of the Board or the majority of the members present at email addresses. There shall be two a membership meeting.

On May 23, 2013, the Association Checks over \$300.00 shall be signed Article VIII, Section 6. The by the President as well as the No donations to individuals, institutions, groups, or charities shall be made by members or directors without prior approval of two-thirds of the members of the the following January; Board present at the next quarterly or Annual Meeting of the Board and in strict conformity with applicable provisions of the law and regulations with the Bylaws of the Corporation

> Article V, Section 4. No elected officer of the Corporation, other than the President, may serve more than two four consecutive full committee members; and their terms in the same office in the contact information, may be found Corporation. The President may in this newsletter. serve no more than two consecutive full terms.

Corporation shall be made by Article IX, Section 3. Electronic Media Committee (Website and Yahoo-Group).

FAIRFAX HIGH SCHOOL SOUND SYSTEM UPDATE

There have been a number of activities that have taken Community Meeting Night: June 12, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. place over the last several months to begin the process at Fairfax High School in Room H106 in the Field of getting approval from the City Council to install the House lobby (use door 21) sound system for the girl's softball field at Fairfax High School. On December 6, 2012 Mayor Scott City Council Meeting - Special Use Permit Hearing: Silverthorne, Council Member and CCH resident Ellie Schmidt, School Board Member and CCH resident Room 100, City Hall Toby Sorensen and Superintendent of Schools Peter Noonan met with the leadership of the Country Club Hills Community Association to begin the discussion and garner support for the sound system. Since that initial meeting, an application was submitted to the City of Fairfax Office of Community Development and Planning to secure a special use permit to allow sound. Further, there have been two "sound nights" at the high school. A third is planned for May 28th.

There will be a community meeting at Fairfax High School to address any further concerns. Finally, the City Council will hold a public hearing on the special use permit.

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
