

Free smoke detector batteries also are available upon request. If you live in the City of Fairfax and you need battery powered smoke detectors for your home, please call 703.385.7830 (TTY 7-1-1) or complete the following online form. A representative of the Fire Department will contact you and schedule an appointment to install your free smoke detectors. Newer homes are equipped with detectors connected to the house wiring. They cannot install or replace this type of detector, however they will replace the batteries if necessary.

The top of the driveway was home to a container garden: overflowing pots of begonias,




