# City Nature Challenge

Help CCH participate in a global Citizen Science Project. Get you and your families out to identify as many different species of plants and wildlife in CCH as we can. The free App iNaturalist can be downloaded and it is as simple as taking a picture, asking what you have observed and uploading right from your phone/ device.

"Invented by citizen science staff at the Natural History Museum of Los Angeles County (Lila Higgins) and California Academy of Sciences (Alison Young). The City Nature Challenge is an international effort for people to find and document plants and wildlife in cities across the globe. It's a bioblitz-style competition where cities are in a contest against each other to see who can make the most observations of nature, who can find the most species, and who can engage the most people."

The observation period for the City Nature Challenge will take place **April 30th through May 3rd**. Observations can still be uploaded to iNaturalist and identified May 4-9. The free app <u>iNaturalist</u> will automatically collect all of the relevant observations during those 4 days.




