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RECYCLING - REDUCE REUSE RECYCLE RESTORE

Our new ACE Hardware Store on Main Street (between Walgreens and TJ Maxx) and Home Depot accept compact fluorescent light bulbs for recycling. Handle the bulbs carefully - easiest thing is to use the packaging the new bulbs come in to hold the old bulbs for recycling.

Summer is here and everybody is thirsty -- try to use reusable pitchers and jugs when possible. A drink in hand is a lot more convenient than a stop at the "convenience" store (and costs a lot less!!). Keep a bag in your car so when you do end up buying drinks on the road and there isn't a recycling container handy, you can stow the empties away and put them in your blue bin when you get home. A little effort will keep a lot of recyclables out of the landfill.

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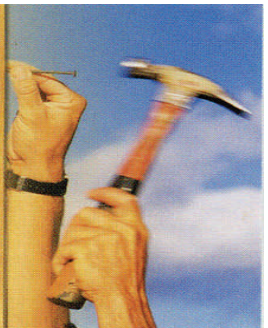
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COUNTRY HILLS GARDEN CLUB UPDATE, JOYCE SKOGLUND -JESKOGLUND@VERIZON.NET

- Country Hill Drive,
- Pinehurst Avenue,
- Broadview Drive,
- Brookwood Drive and
- Farr Drive.

Residents of these streets must display on their vehicles a special city decal that includes a residential parking permit. These neighborhoods have signs advertising the need for these special permits issued by the Treasurer's Office in City Hall.

The neighborhoods requiring parking permits are those near Fairfax High School. Visitors who park in these neighborhoods also need special permits.
