

ANNUAL MEETING OF THE COUNTRY CLUB HILLS CIVIC ASSOCIATION
MAY 18, 2023
Minutes

The evening began at 6:30 pm with pizza and a social half hour.

At 7: 00 pm, President Judy Fraser called the meeting to order and introduced the guest speaker, Anna Safford. Stafford is the Urban Forester for the City of Fairfax. Following a power point presentation, Safford took questions from the audience.

At 7:45, the business meeting began. Copies of both the minutes for the 2022 Annual Meeting and the Treasurer's Report were available. The minutes from the 2022 Annual Meeting were approved. Next came the Treasurer's Report from the Treasurer, Toby Sorensen. As of May 17, 2023, CCHCA has \$10,331.66 on hand. The Treasurer's Report was quickly accepted.

Valentina Garcia, Chairman of the Advertising Committee, reported on her efforts to get more advertising for the newsletter.

Lara Hughes, Director of Social Activities, reported on upcoming events. These include an Ice Cream Social at the end of the school year, and a Labor Day event. She also reported on the potential for future activities with the Old Lee Hills Civic Association.

There was a brief report from Katy Johnson, Director of Social Media. President Judy Fraser announced that she was not seeking another term as president, and Katy Johnson was the candidate for presidency.

Matt Eddy, Director of Community Safety, gave a brief report. There are lots of cameras around town, and we are fortunate in having a good police force.

Jana Craig, in charge of Neighbor to Neighbor, reported efforts in the community. There were brief reports from Katy Lynch, Director of Publications; Stephanie Schneider, Historian; and Donna Sabo, Directory.

There were no nominations from the floor. With the exception of President, the CCHCA Board of 2022 continues into the coming year and was unanimously elected. The only change in that now Katy Johnson is President, and so there is a vacancy for Director of Social Media.
